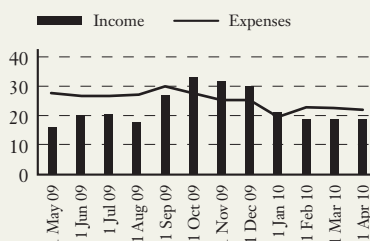
### Building Available For Use

## THIS WEEK'S BLURB

Last weekend in church during the service the Holy Spirit brought a wonderful theme. It was one of those times, when, without any orchestration, the Holy Spirit became the conductor of the service.

This was evidenced as people tuned in to listen, and then explain what they felt God was saying. Several people clearly expressed these God thoughts to the church. These prophetic words were then followed by Hamish's sermon which was on the same prophetic them about being hospitable - in particular to the Holy Spirit. Therefore, because of his sermon and a particular prophecy brought by Karin these 'thoughts' cemented to me a theme of what the Holy Spirit is wanting us to do. I sense it is to further develop these ideas about how to engage with him to give him greater access into our lives - inviting him as our guest, listening to and attending to his needs in our services. The scriptures that captured these thoughts best were those taken from Isaiah 55:1-3 and Revelation 3:20 (TNIV).

I have included a part of both of these in this newsletter to give you time to ponder them so we can ask ourselves to ask: - how can I apply these words in my own life?

Isaiah 55:1-3

1 "Come, all you who are thirsty, come to the waters; and you who have no money, come, buy and eat! Come, buy wine and milk without money and without cost. 2 ... Listen, listen to me, and eat what is good, and you will delight in the richest of fare. 3 Give ear and come to me...

Revelation 3:20

20 Here I am! I stand at the door and knock. If anyone hears my voice and opens the door, I will come in and eat with them, and they with me.
