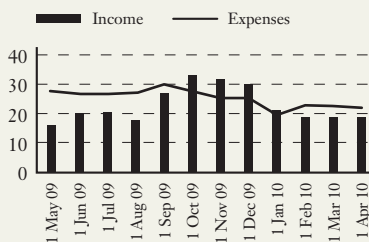

Hi Church.

One of the perplexing things about Jesus that astounds me is how "cool, calm and collected" he seemed to be in the often tumultuous circumstances of his life and ministry. Sure, on occasions he stayed up all night in prayer. Sure, the injustice perpetrated by the moneychangers in the temple infuriated him to the point of active anger. Sure, at times the learning difficulties of his disciples drove him to distraction.

But for a man with the responsibility of the salvation of the entire human race resting on his shoulders, a man often targeted directly by Satan himself, a man consistently and often vehemently opposed by the religio/political consensus of the day; he was able to maintain a remarkable degree of composure.

This was no utopian serenity, blind to the ugly realities going on around him. Nor was

it some kind of spiritual version of a physical or chemical lobotomy. Jesus was fully engaged with life. He didn't live a life of ease, swinging in a hammock under a palm tree, Pina-Colada in hand. He had mountains to climb that would have placed unbelievable demands on him, not the least being the challenge of building the foundation of the Universal and eternal Church.
